



CML SKI MOUNTAINEERING TERMS AND CONDITIONS 2011

1. A ski mountaineering ticket is valid for skiing from 7th March 2011 and for access on those dates that uplift operates for the purpose of downhill snowsports, during standard opening hours.
2. The ski mountaineering ticket will only be sold when appropriate lifts are operating and CML consider conditions to be suitable
3. The snowsports membership pass is non transferable, and no refunds will be made.
4. CairnGorm Mountain Ltd reserves the right to change prices and services at any time and without notification.
5. CairnGorm Mountain Ltd retains the right to close all or any of the lifts at any time, for any reason. Ticket purchasers are reminded that lift operations can be affected by weather and snow conditions.
6. The Company's facilities are used at the ticket holder's own risk. The Company accepts no responsibility for injury, loss or damage unless as a direct result of its negligence.
7. The pass must be shown upon request by CairnGorm Mountain Ltd staff.
8. The ski mountaineering ticket is valid for use on the following surface lifts only, Car Park TBar, Fiacaill Ridge Poma, Coire Cas TBar and M1 Poma.
9. The ski mountaineering ticket is available for use on the day of issue only
10. The ski mountaineering ticket is valid for 2 lifts to reach a point where ski mountaineering can begin. The ticket will be removed by the lift operator at the second lift.
11. The ski mountaineering ticket is sold subject to the user's compliance with the skier's international code of conduct
12. This ticket is not valid with any other ticket or offer and is subject to availability
