- Successful applicants will be notified by 31st October. Passes will be not be posted out but must be collected from the Ticket Office after 1st November 2011.

CAIRNGORM SNOWSPORTS SPONSORED JUNIOR MEMBERSHIP TERMS AND CONDITIONS 2011/2012

1. **Sponsored junior and junior pass holders are not entitled to discount off additional snowsports tickets purchased.**
2. A snowsports member pass is valid for skiing/snowboarding from 1st December and on those dates that uplift operates for the purpose of downhill snowsports, during standard opening hours.
3. The pass will be honoured until lifts cease to operate for skiing and snowboarding.
4. The pass is non transferable, and no refunds will be made.
5. Anyone using or attempting to use somebody else's pass will have the pass confiscated and it will not be returned to the owner.
6. The snowsports membership pass 2011/12 may be used by the holder for funicular use until 30th November 2012. When using your pass during the summer, please present your pass at the Ticket Office, where a funicular ticket will be issued.
7. CairnGorm Mountain Ltd accepts payment by cash, cheque, all major debit/credit cards (excluding American Express) and by standing order (details from ticket office).
8. CairnGorm Mountain Ltd reserves the right to change prices and services at any time without notice.
9. CairnGorm Mountain Ltd retains the right to close all or any of the lifts at any time, for any reason. Snowsports members are reminded that lift operations can be affected by weather and snow conditions.
10. The Company's facilities are used at the pass holder's own risk. The Company accepts no responsibility for injury, loss or damage unless as a direct result of its negligence.
11. If a pass is lost during the current winter season, there will be a £20.00 fee to produce a duplicate.
12. If a snowsports member wishes to ski and is unable to produce their pass on the day, they will be issued with a complimentary day ticket. If they forget their membership pass more than three times during the season, they will be asked to pay the price of a day ticket .
13. The pass must be shown upon request by CairnGorm Mountain Ltd staff and before uplift is used.
14. The carriage of sports equipment unrelated to piste skiing is not permitted on the funicular.
15. The pass is sold subject to the user's compliance with the skier's international code of conduct.
16. The pass is sold on the understanding that the holder will undertake all activity respecting the European Conservation Site Boundaries.
17. Failure to comply with any of the above conditions will result in forfeiture of the snowsports pass.
18. Outwith the ski season, visitors may not exit the Ptarmigan building/viewing terrace except to go on The Walk @ the Top, but they may walk up to the Ptarmigan building and descend by the funicular.
19. The category of pass applied for is related to your age as at 1st Dec 2011.

NB: Please be aware that during the ski season, the ticket office can become extremely busy. Snowsports membership passes are not able to be printed "on the spot." To avoid frustration and disappointment, please submit your application in good time and remember that passes will not be posted out but must be collected from the Ticket Office after 1st November 2011. Thank you for your cooperation.
